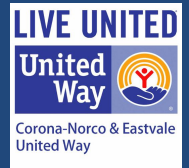

## GED TRAINING PROGRAM AT CORONA-NORCO UNITED WAY

The GED Training Program focuses on providing classroom style lectures, needs assessment, future academic planning and scholarships to adults in our community. The program offers certified teachers in English and Spanish to individuals who are in need of obtaining the high school equivalent diploma.

The GED Training Program is operated throughout the Corona-Norco & Eastvale area in partnership with the CNUSD Adult Education Program, City of Corona, CDBG Fund and individual donations like yours. The program launched in June, 2011.

### Program Goals:

- To Address more than 15.7% of the population in the United Way service areas without a high school diploma.
- Develop a Plan of Action for the student immediate academic goals.
- To provide students with scholarships and additional tools to obtain a higher education.

### Program Services:

Individuals in the program receive:

- **Classroom Style Lectures:** Certified teachers work with the student in obtaining the necessary knowledge in the subjects of Math, Science, Social Studies and Language Arts.
- **Needs Assessment:** Identifying other basic services the client needs such as emergency food, clothing, rental/utility assistance and financial aid. The counselor prioritizes with the client to assist the individual in getting these needs met.
- **Future Academic Planning & Scholarships:** Work one-on-one with a counselor to assess the student financial needs, strengths, set and work on goals and connect to additional community resources.
- **Crisis Intervention:** Connects the student with the Family Support Services in case the need is identified.



### Eligibility Requirements:

The GED Training Program serves individuals who:

- Live within the Corona-Norco United Way service area (Corona, Norco and Eastvale and surrounding unincorporated areas).
- Don't have a high school diploma.
- Need financial assistance to pay for final tests.
